2 decide what to do. The Chair will divide the question.

3 For what purpose does Delegate Weidemeyer rise?

4 DELEGATE WEIDEMEYER: I want to make a point of
5 inquiry of Delegate Maurer or the Chair.

6 If this amendment were to go through, striking
7 out, "unless otherwise provided by law," in lines three and
8 four, on page 8, and then we left in the last sentence, "when
9 a board or commission is at the head of a principal depart-
10 ment", wouldn't that be a gross inconsistency there
11 between the first sentence and that latter sentence?

12 THE CHAIRMAN: If the second question were passed,
13 without the first one being passed, that would be true.

14 If both changes embodied in this amendment were
15 adopted then the point you make would be a valid one. If
16 they were both adopted your point would be well taken.

20 an exception for the State Department of Education and
