

1 A vote on that amendment would test the sentiment
2 of the committee on the precise points you raised.

3 DELEGATE SCANLAN: I hope they do it.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Scanlan.

5 DELEGATE SCANLAN: I don't want to do this. I am
6 in favor of Mrs. Maurer's motion, but I don't think it is
7 fair to those in the Assembly who want to have other areas
8 with a board.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Scanlan, you said you
10 appealed the ruling of the Chair and I am not sure
11 what ruling you referred to.

12 DELEGATE SCANLAN: I thought in effect you ori-
13 ginally acceded to my request, that the question be made
14 divisible and then in yielding to Mrs. Maurer's blandish-
15 ments, that in a general way you restated the question
16 in a way that I think now poses an unfair choice for the
17 convention.

18 They have to take the whole apple unless someone
19 comes forward with this amendment you suggest, and I don't
20 see why you didn't rest with your original decision and let
21 the question be divided, vote A and then vote B.
