6 THE CHAIRMAN: Is the amendment seconded.

7 (Whereupon the motion was seconded.)

8 THE CHAIRMAN: The amendment having been  
9 seconded the Chair recognizes Delegate Morgan to speak  
10 to the amendment.

11 DELEGATE MORGAN: Mr. Chairman, this amendment  
12 limits the powers and functions that the governor may  
13 delegate to the lieutenant governor. Any power or func-  
14 tion specifically given to the Governor by this Constitu-  
15 tion may not be delegated to the lieutenant governor under  
16 this section. It can only be vested in the lieutenant  
17 governor by the lieutenant governor becoming active  
18 governor under Section 4.07, that is when the governor  
19 notifies the lieutenant governor in writing that he will  
20 be temporarily unable to carry out his duties. These
