13 lieutenant governor, who might be more friendly, will  
14 apoint the Commissioner of Police of Baltimore? Is it pos-  
15 sible under what you are saying?

17 DELEGATE MORGAN: No, it is not possible because  
18 that is a constitutional function of the government.
