4 DELEGATE MORGAN: Well, the legislature gives
5 executive power to the head of the department and he per-
6 forms executive power and the governor can vest executive
7 power in the lieutenant governor if the Constitution says
8 so.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gilchrist.

10 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: That is a delegation which
11 the executive approved.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Morgan.

13 DELEGATE MORGAN: Are you talking about the
14 delegation of which the executive approved?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gilchrist.

16 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: By signing the bill the
17 governor approves the delegation which is made by the
18 legislature. You have constitutionally vested power, the
19 executive power by your first section in the governor.
