2 DELEGATE WAGANDT: I believe that Section 3.02  
3 is the proper place for this. I assume that the redistrict-  
4 ing commission and also the General Assembly will be forced  
5 to comply to this provision, if it is accepted.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Barrick, any further  
7 questions?

8 DELEGATE BARRICK: No; I don't agree with his  
9 answer, but I have no other questions.
