

1 the Committee concurs as well, so long as it is understood,
2 and as Delegate Gleason, that the first view and first
3 observation by the Court of Appeals would be the legis-
4 lature's plan. If it should decide that that plan was
5 unconstitutional, then and only then would it move to a
6 consideration of the commission plan.

7 Mr. Chairman, I am advised by the staff, and I
8 believe that it would be appropriate to include in line 35
9 at the end thereof, after "becomes", the words, "or would
10 become", and I would ask Delegate Case if he would adopt
11 that additional language.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

13 DELEGATE CASE: Yes, certainly, Delegate
14 Gallagher.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: As the Chair understands it then
16 the amendment would be modified to add the following
17 language, beginning on line 5, and in line 35, after the
18 word, "becomes", add the words, "or would become". Is
19 that correct?

20 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Yes.
