3 DELEGATE CLARK: Delegate Dukes.

4 DELEGATE DUKES: Yes, sir, I will be glad to do
5 so. I don't think the Constitution is a place where we
6 ^{should} ~~shall~~ try to say you shall or shall not try to do a number
7 of things which I consider to be the duty of the legisla-
8 ture. I feel a number of items that we have passed already
9 probably fall in that category. Some I voted for, some I
10 voted against. Some I voted for only because others
11 had passed and I wanted to be consistent.

12 I can give you a list of half a dozen other
13 things already that I don't think belong in the Constitu-
14 tion. This easily is one of them. I think it is very
15 clear that if we put this ban in the Constitution, it
16 stands out like a lone pine tree on a hill among all the
17 sins that go on in the State.

18 We simply would have made an announcement that
19 means nothing whatsoever, we will have picked out an iso-
20 lated consensus of evil, I suppose, by the group that has
21 been sent down here and we will not begin to touch on all
