

1 DELEGATE SHERBOW: Yes.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: Is that your question, Delegate
3 Case?

4 DELEGATE CASE: Mr. Chairman, that answers the
5 question but I respectfully call to your attention that I
6 think it is the wrong answer. This says lotteries shall
7 not be authorized by the State or its local political sub-
8 divisions. Assume with me that there is no statute on the
9 subject at all. I just don't see wherein this prohibited
10 the corporation from being formed for the express purpose
11 of holding the lottery.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Sherbow.

13 DELEGATE SHERBOW: The answer is that the State
14 has in its Constitution, that State lotteries shall not be
15 authorized by the State or its political subdivisions and
16 if they are not authorized, they are not lawful.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

18 DELEGATE CASE: But the nonauthorization is by
19 the State or its political subdivisions, it is limited to
20 that. It is not a complete absolute ban on lotteries and
21 this is what I thought the committee was trying to reach.
