

1 the Grandfather Clause so far as the political subdivi-  
2 sions are concerned. But that sentence Number 2 had been  
3 considered.

4 I think actually both have already been passed  
5 upon and are in the last sentence of 7.05, the Local Govern-  
6 ment article, if I am not mistaken, so that sub-paragraph B  
7 would not require any further action at this time. Is  
8 that not correct?

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

10 DELEGATE CASE: I would defer to you, Delegate  
11 Needle, on this. You are the expert on local government.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Needle.

13 DELEGATE NEEDLE: Not at all, but I think it  
14 would save a lot of time if I just read to you that one  
15 sentence. You might agree Paragraph B would not require  
16 any further action.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

19 is something that will not require action, I will agree
