2 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Case.

3 DELEGATE CASE: Delegate Hanson, you now reach
4 me in an ambivalency which results from the fact that
5 I was a member of the so-called Eney Commission on the
6 one hand, and a member of this Convention on the other.

7 You will find if you read the report of the
8 Commission that the word "may" was used. I was Chairman
9 of the Tax Committee of that Commission and it was
10 my recommendation at the time, it was the unanimous recom-
11 mendation of the Commission, that the word "may" should
12 be used. That is the way it came to this body.

13 On the other hand, an abundance of intelli-
14 gence came to the Committee by way of testimony from
15 interested groups, from farmers singly and in combina-
16 tion, from the State Board of Agriculture, from the Grange,
17 from the Farm Bureau, from farmers throughout this state.
