3 municipalities is determined by the municipality.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gullett, do you desire
5 to submit your amendment B as a substitute for Amendment
6 7?

7 DELEGATE GULLETT: Yes, I do. Am I in order to
8 speak on that, sir?

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Just a minute. The amendment
10 has been distributed, it will be numbered 7-A to Amendment
11 7.

13 MR. QUILLEN: Amendment Number 7-A to Committee
14 Recommendation Number S&E-2, by Delegate Gullett.

15 On page 2 Section 2 Eligible Voters in Munici-
16 pal Elections strike out all of lines 4 through 9, in-
17 clusive, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

18 "may be established by law by municipal corpora-
19 tions subject to such procedures and standards as the
20 General Assembly may provide by public general laws. No
21 municipal corporation may establish a voting age require-
ment of more than nineteen years nor a residency
