

1           THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bamberger, with unani-  
2           mous consent, submits the unprinted amendment to strike  
3           from lines 10 and 11 the words "of more than 19 years" and  
4           to insert in lieu thereof the words "different from the  
5           voting age for state elections".

6                     Is there a second?

7           DELEGATE BYRNES: I second it.

8           THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bamberger may speak  
9           to it. This will be Amendment 8A.

10           DELEGATE BAMBERGER: I think there is obvious  
11           logic for allowing a municipal corporation to have a  
12           different requirement of residency, because of the mobility  
13           of population, the smaller size of the geographic area  
14           of municipalities, and the nature of the issues of the  
15           municipalities which would tend not to be the subject  
16           of mass media, of television and of the state-wide news-  
17           paper.

18                     I see considerable logic behind the require-  
19           ment that one might be required to live longer in a  
20           municipality. I think also, as we discussed before, there  
21           is some logic to the idea that people who own taxable
