

1 not prohibit the Attorney General from acting as a legal
2 adviser or counsellor for such an administrative agency but
3 I do not believe that a lawyer for an agency ought to be also
4 one of the policy makers of the agency.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bennett.

6 DELEGATE BENNETT: What we want to do, do we not, is
7 to get a man of high caliber and a person of broad experience
8 and a person looking forward to a broad scope of duties
9 in this office and I am afraid that this would restrict it
10 and that we won't get the kind of man that we need for the
11 Attorney General, if we limit ti to being a desk lawyer.

12 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: I do not think he is a desk
13 lawyer at all. He is a lawyer for the corporation but he
14 is not one of the directors of the corporation and those are
15 different functions.
