3 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Sybert.

4 DELEGATE SYBERT: Would it not as a matter of fact, be
5 intolerable if an Attorney General appointed a man as an
6 assistant that he thought was incompetent?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: May I remind you this period is for
8 asking questions and not debate.

9 DELEGATE SYBERT: I understand.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: I know you understand, but your questions
11 are taking the character of debate.

12 DELEGATE SYBERT: I will desist.

13 DELEGATE MASON: Even if the legislature would prescribe
14 by law that the assistants be under the merit system, under your
15 amendment, the Attorney General under the rules prescribed by
16 the merit system would have that right to a point. Is that
17 what you intend doing?
