5 Delegate Weidemeyer.

6 DELEGATE WEIDEMEYER: Mr. President and Delegates
7 of the Convention, for the benefit of Delegates Miller and
8 Taylor I might state that, as the President pointed out,
9 our preamble recognizes the fact that all power emanates
10 from the people, and also in our Recommendation R&P-2,
11 section 2, which is the 10th Amendment of the Constitution
12 of the United States, it recognizes also that power is
13 reserved to the people, and such power is not granted to
14 the Federal government in the Constitution, nor prohibited
15 by that document to the States; and it is reserved to the
16 State and the people respectively. With those two things
17 in mind, I think they will probably not want to insert
18 further amendments.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Very well.
