

1 Delegate Marion.

2 DELEGATE MARION: Just a question of Delegate
3 Adkins.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: State the question.

5 DELEGATE MARION: I wasn't clear how the colloquy
6 you had with the Chair ended up as to whether or not this
7 language, whether or not your intention by this language
8 was to get a pre-trial proceeding --

9 THE CHAIRMAN: He said, No.

10 DELEGATE MARION: It would only apply then to
11 at the time of trial, is that the intention which you had
12 in mind?

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Adkins.

14 DELEGATE ADKINS: It is certainly not meant or
15 my intention and I think Delegate Scanlan's is not certainly
16 meant to indicate that we should not have the right to
17 cross-examination at the pre-trial, but we had not intended
18 that the Constitutional guarantee hearing provided would
19 necessarily go to that extent. This is limited to the
20 language of the proposal here, which is at the trial stage.
