

1 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Bamberger.

2 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: At least in that respect  
3 you would not object to 5-B if we remove from it its  
4 exclusion of cases punishable by death or life imprison-  
5 ment?

6 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Child.

7 DELEGATE CHILD: I would object to it. We  
8 don't need it. The old language is sufficient.

9 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Bamberger.

10 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: You say the old language  
11 is implicitly gives the right to bail in cases which are  
12 punishable by death or life imprisonment?

13 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Child.

14 DELEGATE CHILD: It has been so interpreted  
15 by the rules and statute.

16 DELEGATE BAMBERGER: In what other respect does  
17 Section 5-B state rights which are not implicit in  
18 Section 8?
