2 didn't want to furnish bail, if he wanted to make the
3 state show it and under the law the judge must hear a
4 writ of habeas corpus very, very promptly.

5 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Grant.

6 DELEGATE GRANT: Judge Child, assuming that
7 Section B was kept in the Constitution, would it be
8 acceptable to you if the words were added to it, "unless
9 public safety would otherwise require"?

10 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Child.

11 DELEGATE CHILD: Well, I think it would be very
12 unwise to keep it in there at all under the present language.

13 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Cicone.

14 DELEGATE CICONE: Judge Child, in view of some
15 of the questions asked about whether you thought it was
16 proper that a rich man who could afford bail --

17 DELEGATE CHILD: Pardon me, I didn't hear the
18 first part of the question.

19 DELEGATE CICONE: I am a little mixed up on
20 some of these questions.

21 I thought I had it clear. I would like to ask
