

1 THE PRESIDENT: If you merely wish to
2 indicate for the record the way in which you would have
3 voted, had you been present, the Chair will permit it.
4 The Chair will not permit you to vote after the vote has
5 been recorded, because it could perhaps affect the
6 result, and that cannot be permitted. You may state how
7 you would have voted had you been here to vote.

8 DELEGATE HUTCHINSON: I would have voted Aye,
9 I believe.

10 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Robey, have you had
11 the memorandum now?

12 DELEGATE ROBEY: We have the memorandum now.
13 Thank you, Mr. President.

14 THE PRESIDENT: Are you ready for the question?
15 The clerk will ring the quorum bell.

16 The question arises on the adoption of Amendment
17 No. 1. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the amendment.
18 A vote No is a vote against.

19 Cast your vote.

20 Have all delegates voted? Does any delegate
21 desire to change his vote?
