3 could hold more than one office of profit, to the determina-  
4 tion of the General Assembly?

5 The answer is --

6 DELEGATE SICKLES: -- Yes.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Burdette, do you have  
8 a further question?

9 DELEGATE BURDETTE: I would say, Mr. President,  
10 I think this is a very dangerous departure from the  
11 principle of separation of powers in order to face a  
12 particular and specific problem; that we are legislating  
13 here in a fashion that may be most undesirable.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Does any other delegate desire  
15 to speak? Is there any further discussion?

16 Are you ready for the question?

19 No. 6, as modified. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the
