

A Court held by their Majesties Justices of the Peace for the County of Somerset in the County of Maryland the nineteenth day of September in the second year of their Majesties Queen Anne & Mary King & Queen Over England &c. Anno Domini 1690

on this present { Mr. Francis Jenkins. Mr. James Round. Mr. James Darrell. Mr. Samuel Hopkins. Mr. Thomas Jones.

That a Negro servant to Daniel Solby was brought into Court to be judged what he deserved & what he ought to have after a full view had. This Court judged he deserved to be sold

for arrears by his attorney in Chancery. Being the sum of £100 & was of this Court to answer a Declaration already filed agt. Walter Rogers which was granted.

Ordered by this Court that all Petitions for Exonerated attendants, being sworn to before one Justice of the Peace or two other Justices out of Court, or sworn to before one Justice in Court, be sufficient Proof for so attendants.

Persons found for coming within Barr of Court not being called, were: Peter Whaples. Roger, Gurdam. James: Suite. Daniel: Sumner. Thomas: Sull. John: Freeman and John: Dillip.

Ordered that the Constables of Momy Hundred, take the taxable Inhabitants of the said Island into the list of taxable. It being Ordered into the Court.

Order Mr. James Round and John: Smith, to appraise the Estate of Samuel: Gumb of this County &c. Order Mr. Samuel: Hopkins swear the so appraised.

Order John: Anderson Overseer of the Highways, in and place of Mr. Ja: Sauffe

Ordered that the respective Overseers of their Majesties Highways do forthwith cause their Inhabitants in their parishes to amend the said Highways & Bridges.

Compt. County of Somerset. Most: Hamlen of this County makes Oath that he has deponent attended as a witness in a Cause depending between Walter: Mathewitt & pet. and William: Giddals and Elizabeth: Howwell. &c. &c. &c. Fourteen days for wages & also prays an Order that 3^d day of September 1690. This being 3. Courts attendants. Most: Hamlen.
