

Sec. 14. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, the General Assembly reserving the right to alter, repeal, or amend this Act at pleasure. In force and reservation.

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Treasurer to pay to Mrs. Frances Miller, a sum of money due William R. Miller, deceased, for per diem and mileage, as a member of the Legislature of Maryland, at the session of eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller issue his warrant to the Treasurer, authorizing and directing him to pay to Mrs. Frances Miller, mother of William R. Miller, deceased, the sum of one hundred and seventeen dollars, that sum being the amount of per diem and mileage due the said deceased as a member of the Legislature of Maryland, at the session of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, from Cecil County. Appropriation of money.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to repeal Section five of Article sixty, of Public General Laws, entitled "Marriages," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section five of Article sixty, of Public General Laws, entitled Marriages, be and Marriages.
