Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Ellicott City and Clarksville Turnpike Company,

Being upon a second reading,

Sec. 16. And be it enacted that this company shall not be privileged to charge tolls on any vehicle passing over this road for the purpose of attending a funeral.
