LEGAL HOLIDAYS

1. Fixed

Should any of the dates listed above fall on a Sunday, the holiday is observed on the following Monday, with the single exception of February 12, Lincoln's Birthday.

2. Movable

All special days that may be appointed or recommended by the Governor of Maryland or the President of the United States.

3. Saturdays

It is lawful for banks in Maryland to close their doors at twelve o'clock noon on every Saturday of the year. After twelve o'clock noon, Saturday is a legal holiday. This does not apply in the following counties: Baltimore, Caroline, Howard, and Talbot. (1947 Supplement to the Annotated Code of Public General Laws, Art. 13, Sec. 11).


Special Observances
