Mr. Clarke, from the Committee on Corporations, to whom was referred House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Western Maryland Extension Railroad Company, reported it with the following amendment:

Amend by inserting the names of C. C. Fulton and Frederick Raine, of Baltimere city.

Said bill was then read the second time.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:
