

be appointed in such manner, as shall by ordinance be directed ; and they and all officers herein named, shall receive such salaries, as shall be fixed from time to time by ordinance of the Corporation. Officers of Corporation, how appointed.

105. The Mayor shall, in lieu of fees, receive an annual salary to be fixed by ordinance of the Corporation, and every ordinance fixing such compensation shall continue in force for one year and no longer. Salary of Mayor.

145. All fines, fees and costs shall go to the Corporation, and shall be appropriated as directed ordinance. Disposition of fees and costs.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 155.

AN ACT to add additional sections to Article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick County, in regard to horses and carriages kept at livery in Frederick Town.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following Sections be, and they are hereby added to Article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick County, and be annexed under a separate title as "Horses and Carriages at Livery, as follows : Additional sections.

1. It shall be lawful for any livery stable keeper in Frederick Town to retain in his custody any horse, mare or gelding, placed under his care for livery, and also any vehicle, until all charges for so keeping shall have been paid by the owner or owners thereof. May retain until charges are paid.

2. It shall and may be lawful for such livery stable keeper to sell any such horse, mare or gelding, or vehicle at public auction, for cash, in Frederick Town, after giving at least three weeks public notice of the time, place and terms of sale in one or more newspapers published in Frederick Town prior to the day of sale, and after deducting the amount due Sell at auction.
