There shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables in Frederick County, to wit: For election district number one, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number two, seven justices of the peace and six constables; for election district number three, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number four, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number five, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number six, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number seven, four justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number eight, four justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number nine, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number ten, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number eleven, four justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number twelve, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number thirteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number fourteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number fifteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number sixteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number seventeen, two justices of the peace and two constables.
