Leave was granted to the Judiciary Committee to introduce a bill to amend 16th Article of Public General Laws, relating to Chancery, by repealing Act of 1861, chapter 32, and adding to said Article the following section relating to Injunctions and Receivers.

Mr. Blake, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably a bill entitled "An Act to repeal Section 1, Article 11, Constitution of Maryland."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Purnell, Chairman of a Select Committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, "An Act to amend an Act," passed March 18th, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, entitled "An Act to revive and extend an Act to incorporate the Worcester Railroad Company," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, with amendments.

Which was read a first time.

The bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 939, Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to Baltimore City," sub-title "Water," as enacted by chapter 467 of the Acts of Assembly, passed at the January session, 1868, and to re-enact the said section so as to read as follows:
