On motion of Mr. Clark, of Baltimore City, (the rules being suspended,)

The House proceeded to the consideration of

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace for the second election district, and also an additional Justice of the Peace for the ninth election district in Frederick county.

Said bill being upon a third reading,

On motion of Mr. Clark, of Baltimore City,

The further consideration thereof was postponed, and the bill recommitted to the Committee on the Judiciary.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, in the year 1868, chapter 134, approved March 30, 1868, entitled an Act supplementary and amendatory of an Act passed at the present Session of the Legislature of Maryland, entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Cumberland and Pennsylvania Railroad Company, passed at January Session, 1849, chapter 469.
