

## AFTERNOON SESSION.

MONDAY, 4 O'CLOCK P. M., APRIL 1, 1872.

The Senate met.

Mr. Henderson, the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars in equal proportion, and also to pay to each one of the above named ministers the sum of twenty-five dollars each, in lieu of stationery.
