

and thereon to build and erect Houfes for entertain-
ment of the Poor, and providing neceffaries for their re-
lief.

II. The faid Trustees fome time before the 10th of
April next, fhall meet together on the faid Land, and
then and there agree with the Parties interefted, and buy
the faid 50 Acres, in which the faid Springs fhall be in-
cluded.

III. If the Proprietors of the faid Land fhall refufe to
fell, or be disabled to make a good Title to the fame,
then the High Sher. of *St Maries* County fhall impannel
12 Freeholders, who upon their Oaths fhall value the
faid 50 Acres, as it fhall be Surveyed and laid out by
direction of the Trustees.

IV. The fum to be paid for the Purchase fhall be le-
vied by an equal Affeffment upon the Inhabitants of
this Province. And whatever the faid Trustees fhall
do in purfuanee thereof, is hereby ratified and con-
firmed, and the faid Trustees fhall be indemnified, &c.

Weights and Measures.

I. *An. 4. W. & M. 1692. p. 14.* No other Weights
and Measures fhall be ufed in Trading, than what are
according to the Statute of *Henry 7, King of England.*

V. 11. H. persons fhall be appointed by the Juftices of
7. ch. 4. & the feveral Counties, to take care of the
12. H. 7. Standard, Weights and Measures, who are
ch. 5. to provide all fuch Weights and Measures as
are wanting.

II. There fhall be in each County 12 half hundred
Weights, a quarter, a half quarter, a 7 pound weight,
4 pound, 2 pound and one pound ; alfo Brals measures
of Ells and Yard feald in *England* ; likewise Bufhel, half
Bufhel, Peck and Gallon of *Wincheſter* measure, with
Gallon, Pottle, Quart, Pint and half Pint of Wine mea-
ſure, with burnt Stamps for Wooden Measures, and other
Stamps for Pewter. The persons appointed and pro-
curing the fame, to be reimbursed out of the County
levy.

III. To which Standards all persons are to repair and
bring their Stilliards yearly to be tryed and ſtamp'd, pay-
ing 2 s. So alfo for Barrels, Buſhels, &c. paying for
each
