Days in Bank.

The day in leap-year and the day before, accounted one. 21 Henry 3.

Debt and Debtors.

Debtor dying, the public shall be first paid. 9 Henry 3, Ch. 18.

How sureties charged to King. 9 Henry 3, Ch. 8.

Deeds.

Demurrer.

Judgment shall be given on demurrer according to the right of the cause without regarding form, unless shewed. 27 Elizabeth, Ch. 5; 4 Anne, Ch. 16, S. 1.

Descent.

Descents shall not take away the right of entry, unless disseisor was in peaceable possession for five years. 32 Henry 8, Ch. 33.

Detainer.

See *Forcible Entry.*

Devastavit.

Action may be sustained by creditor of first testator against the executor of his executor, suggesting *devastavit* by the first executor of the goods of his testator. 30 Charles 2, Ch. 7; 4 & 5 William & Mary, Ch. 24.

Devises.

Dilatory Plea.

Not to be put in without affidavit. 4 Anne, Ch. 16, S. 11.

Disclaimer.

Where pleadable in trespass. 21 James 1, Ch. 16, S. 5.
