station house at such other hours and times as his duties may require, or as he may be required so to do by the County Commissioners, or by the State's Attorney for Baltimore County; and each of said justices so selected from the 13th Election District to sit at the station house at Mt. Winans and St. Denis, respectively, in said district, shall keep his office at the station house for which he was appointed and shall attend said station house every day (Sundays excepted) at such hours and times as his duties may require, or as he may be required to do by the County Commissioners or by the State's Attorney for Baltimore County; when any such justice appointed to sit at any of the station houses aforesaid shall designate any other justice of the peace to act for him in his absence, it shall first be necessary for him to obtain the consent of the County Commissioners allowing such justice to act for him; the said justice of the peace so selected to sit at the station house at Canton in the 12th Election District shall transact only criminal business at such station house, and no civil business whatsoever, except such affidavits and acknowledgments in civil matters as he may from time to time be required to take for the convenience of the public; and for any violation of this provision he shall be liable to indictment by the grand jury of said county, and on conviction shall be fined one hundred dollars and shall be disqualified from holding his office.

Changing of  
justices at

140. The justice of the peace, so selected to sit at any station house referred to in the preceding section, may be changed from time to time by the Governor at his discretion during the term for which such justice was appointed, and any other justice of the peace appointed for said district may be selected by the Governor to perform the said duties at said station house.

Jurisdiction  
concurrent

141. The several justices of the peace for Baltimore County, including the station house justices for said 12th and 13th Election Districts, shall have jurisdiction concurrent with that exercised by the Circuit Court for said county in all cases of assault, without any felonious intent; and in all cases of assault and battery, and in all misdemeanors not punishable by confinement in the penitentiary, which may be committed within said county, and shall have jurisdiction in all prosecutions or proceedings for the recovery of any penalty for doing or omitting to do any act, the doing of which or the omission to do which, is made punishable under the laws of this State, within their said jurisdiction by any pecuniary fine or penalty,
