

twenty thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906; provided, however, the said appropriations shall be paid out of the appropriations for the relief of the destitute in the City of Baltimore, as passed at the Session of 1904, Chapter 129.

Home of the Aged (Salisbury).

80. To the Home of the Aged, at Salisbury, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

Hebrew Children and Protective Association.

81. To the Hebrew Children and Protective Association of Baltimore City, the sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

McDonough Institute (La Plata, Md.).

82. To the McDonough Institute, La Plata, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906; provided, however, that the said McDonough Charity School, a corporation, shall provide six free scholarships and six tuition scholarships to students of Charles County, who shall be appointed by the School Commissioners of said Charles County, with the approval in writing of the Senator for that County; and be it further enacted, That the Treasurer of the State shall, upon the warrant of the Comptroller of the State Treasury, pay such sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes hereinbefore specified to or upon the order of the trustees of the McDonough Charity School, a corporation; provided, however, that before any portion of the said money shall be so paid the trustees of the said McDonough Charity School shall file with the Treasurer of the State a bond with surety to be approved by him in the penalty double the amount of the aggregate sum herein appropriated, conditioned for the performance of the condition hereinbefore imposed as to furnishing said scholarships.

Women's Medical College.

85. To the Women's Medical College, for the use of the Good Samaritan Hospital, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and a like sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

Emergency Hospital of Frederick.

86. To the Emergency Hospital of Frederick, the sum of twelve hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and a like sum of twelve hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

Proviso.

87. Provided, however, that any charitable or medical institution or institutions coming under the provisions of this Act shall, at the end of each fiscal year, make to the Comptroller of this State an itemized statement with an affidavit attached
