

duty of the said commissioner to make out, under his hand and the seal of his office, and transmit to the Court of Appeals, a transcript of the record of proceedings in such case, within sixty days from the time of the appeal taken; but in such transcript no paper or proceeding not necessary to the determination of the appeal shall be incorporated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT to repeal Section 178C of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," sub-title "Jurors," as enacted by Chapter 451 of the Acts of 1900, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 178C of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," sub-title "Jurors," as enacted by Chapter 451 of the Acts of 1900, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

178C. No person shall be drawn and summoned again as a juror in Allegany County until the expiration of four years from the term of court at which he last served; provided, that a failure to comply with this section shall not affect the validity of any verdict which may be rendered.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 222, Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Baltimore County," sub-title "Sheriff," as amended by Act of the General Assembly 1900, Chapter 400.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 222 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Baltimore County," sub-title "Sheriff," as amended by the Act of the General Assembly of 1900, Chapter 400, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:
