

Master plumbers to register names.

and house drainage in any said incorporated city or town in Allegany County shall register his or her name in a book to be provided for that purpose by the Board of Health, giving full name, residence and place of business, and in case of removal from place to place said change shall at once be recorded, and shall further display at his or her place of business, in a conspicuous place, a sign with the full registered name as follows: (Name) "Registered Master Plumber, License No. _____" in letters not less than two inches in size.

All plans of sewerage to be filed with the Inspector.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That before any portion of the soil, waste or drainage system of any building shall be laid or constructed there shall be filed by the master plumber with the Inspector of Plumbing, for the use of said Inspector and the Board of Health, a plan thereof, showing the said system from its connection with the main sewer, cesspool or any other outlet and connections in the building, and its extensions up to and through the ventilators, together with the location of all traps, ventilators, etc. The name of the plumber or plumbers who are to perform the work shall be given with the plans; said plans shall first be approved by the Inspector and the Board of Health before a permit to erect, construct or build said work shall be allowed.

Permit to be connected with sewer.

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That no house shall be allowed to be connected with any sewer, either private or public, unless a permit be obtained as provided for in this Act, and all plumbers are required to notify the Inspector of Plumbing of any and all extensions or alterations of water pipes, ventilators or drain fixtures made in any house, dwellings, storeroom or other building or part of building.

Forms of applications.

SEC. 17. *And be it enacted*, That blank forms of applications shall be furnished all plumbers, and all applications must contain, in addition to that which this Act already requires, the name of the owner of the premises, together with his or her or their address, signed by his, her or their signature, or by agent only, when the owner of said premises is not within the said county.

Connections with sewers.

SEC. 18. *And be it enacted*, That all connections with sewers and cesspools must be inspected by the Inspector of Plumbing, and no trench shall be filled until the approval of said Inspector is first obtained; sewer pipes of small drains must not be raised or lowered or otherwise changed until a permit, as provided for in this Act, shall first have been obtained.
