

used to purchase the old school building in the town of Kensington, in said county, and to equip the same as a manual training school, and to make necessary repairs to the new school building in said town, and in such denominations and for such period or periods as said County Commissioners may deem expedient. The said bonds to be issued in series maturing as said County Commissioners shall determine and bear interest not exceeding four per centum per annum from date; all of which bonds shall be exempt from county and municipal taxes; and for the purpose of paying such bonds as they mature the said County Commissioners are hereby directed to levy in each and every year upon the assessable property of said county, to be collected as other county taxes now are or as may be directed by any general or special law for the collection of county taxes, such sum as shall be sufficient to pay the interest on such of said bonds as may then remain unpaid, and also the principal of such bond or bonds as may mature within the fiscal year for which the levy is made. And the County School Commissioners of said county shall, as soon as practicable, sell the old school house building in the town of Rockville, and they shall apply the proceeds of such sale to the redemption of said bonds authorized to be issued by this Act in so far as the same may be possible.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 221.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County and the Town Commissioners of Centreville to sell, grant and convey, in fee simple or lease, a part of the public land in Centreville, Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

WHEREAS, The town hall in Centreville, belonging to Saint Tammany Lodge, No. 25, of the Order of Independent Odd Fellows, a body corporate, is located on the public land in said town of Centreville, Queen Anne's County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, The said hall is now too small to accommodate the purposes for which it was built a number of years ago, and being the only assembly room in said town and a convenience and benefit to the public, it is desired by the owner to remodel or rebuild it, and to enable it to do so with security it is necessary for said body corporate to acquire the title to the land
