

subsequent sales and conveyances of parts of said lands made by said Commissioners.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all deeds heretofore made and delivered to the Commissioners of Easton for any lands in Talbot County, and all subsequent sales and conveyances of any part thereof, made by the said Commissioners, shall have the same effect and operation in law, and be as valid to all intents and purposes as if the General Assembly had previously authorized the Commissioners to acquire title to said lands, and to make conveyance therefor to any purchaser or purchasers of any part thereof.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 233.

AN ACT to amend Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," by adding certain new sections thereto to follow Section 263C, and to be known as Sections 263D, 263E, 263F, 263G and 263H, and to regulate the issue and redemption of trading stamps and other similar devices.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Article 27 of the Code, title "Crimes and Punishments," be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following five sections, to be known as Sections 263D, 263E, 263F, 263G and 263H, and to follow Section 263C:

263D. No person, firm or corporation shall sell or issue any stamps, trading stamps, cash discount stamps, check, ticket, coupon or other similar device, which will entitle the holder thereof, on presentation thereof, either singly or in definite number, to receive either directly from the vendor or indirectly through any other person, money or goods, wares or merchandise, unless each of said stamps, trading stamps, cash discount stamps, checks, tickets, coupons or other similar devices shall have legally printed or written upon the face thereof the redeemable value thereof in cents.

263E. Any person who shall sell or issue to any person engaged in any trade, business or profession, any stamps, trad-
