

“Galena,” and to enact in lieu thereof the following sections, to become Sections 127 and 134, and the additional Section 136 of said Article under said sub-title of “Galena.”

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 127 and 134 of Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title “Kent County,” sub-title “Galena,” be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following be and they are hereby enacted in lieu thereof, to be Sections 127 and 134, and the additional Section 136 of said Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title “Kent County,” sub-title “Galena.”

127. An election shall be held on the first Monday of May, in the year 1904, and on the first Monday in May in each year thereafter, for the purpose of electing three persons out of the legal voters of said town as Commissioners, who shall hold their office for one year, and until their successors are chosen and qualified.

134. The limits of said town of Galena are extended so as to embrace all the territory within the following metes and bounds, and forming a parallelogram, two sides of which shall measure eight hundred and eighty yards each, and two sides shall measure twelve hundred and eighty yards each, and three sides of which extending, respectively, in a southerly, easterly and westerly direction, shall each be four hundred and forty yards distant from the centre of the crossing of the public roads in said town, one road leading from Chestertown to Sassafras, and the other road leading from Lambson’s to Georgetown, and the fourth side extending in a northerly direction eight hundred and forty yards from the centre of the crossing of said roads to Mill lane.

136. The County Commissioners of Kent County shall annually, on or before the first day of January, 1905, and every year thereafter, pay over to the Commissioners of Galena that proportion of the entire county levy for roads and bridges which the total property assessed within the limits of Galena bears to the whole amount of assessed property of Kent County, so that the Commissioners of Galena may receive and disburse the amount levied upon the property within the limits of Galena for roads and bridges by said County Commissioners of Kent County.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
