CHAPTER 308.

AN ACT to add an additional section to Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to be known as Section 37A, to require the Clerk of the County Commissioners to mail or deliver commissions to the Supervisors of Roads.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an additional section be added to Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Garrett County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow Section 37 and to be known as Section 37A, and to read as follows:

37A. That it shall be the duty of the Clerk of the County Commissioners to mail or deliver all commissions to the Supervisors of Roads, for which service the Clerk shall not be entitled to make any charge, the same being made a part of his official duty as Clerk. Supervisors of Roads.

CHAPTER 309.

AN ACT to amend and add certain new sections to Article 18 of the Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Queenstown," as amended and re-enacted by Chapter 542 of the Acts of the General Assembly at its January Session, 1892, empowering the Commissioners of Queenstown to compel property holders to erect and build sidewalks.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Queenstown," be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto certain additional sections to be classed under the sub-title Amending a section.
