

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

CHAPTER 450.

AN ACT to repeal Section 1 and Section 12 of the Acts passed at the January Session, 1900, Chapter 225, being "An Act to incorporate the Consolidated Trust and Finance Company of Maryland, and to change the name of said corporation and the title thereof," and to enact the following in lieu of Section 1 and Section 12 of said Acts.

Consolidated Finance Company of Maryland. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the title of said corporation shall be the Consolidated Finance Company of Maryland; that Section 1 and Section 12 of the Acts passed at the January Session, 1900, Chapter 225, to incorporate the Consolidated Trust and Finance Company of Maryland, be and the same are hereby repealed and the following is enacted in lieu thereof, so as to make Section 1 and Section 12 of the original Act read as follows:

Created a body corporate. 1. That Charles H. Brown, Jr., Joseph H. Dawson, Arthur Pue, H. Edgeworth Frick and Chester F. Johnson, and the subscribers to the stock of the corporation hereby created, and their successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a body corporate by the name of the Consolidated Finance Company of Maryland, and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall be competent to sue and be sued in any court of law or equity whatsoever, to have and to use a common seal, and to alter the same at its pleasure, and to make and to adopt a constitution and by-laws for the government of said body corporate and its officers, agents and employees, and from time to time amend the same; provided such constitution, by-laws or amendments thereto shall not conflict with the Constitution and laws of this State or of the United States; to elect or appoint directors and officers, and generally to do, execute and enforce all and singular such acts, contracts, matters and things as may be necessary to carry out the objects and purposes and to protect the interests of said body corporate, and to exercise the power or powers by this Act conferred upon it. The office of said corporation shall be located in Baltimore City, Maryland.

The corporation hereby incorporated shall have the right and power to engage in building operations, construction of buildings, and shall have the power to guarantee the contracts of contractors for constructing same, and shall also have the right of acquiring, operating and being agent for any steamships, either foreign or domestic, and shall have the power to
