Passed Mar. 15, 1834 Resolution authorising the Governor and Council to contract for the building of a Gun House in the city of Annapolis.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and Council be and they are hereby authorised and required to contract for the building of a small gun house, to be situated in the city of Annapolis: Provided, the same shall not cost exceeding the sum of five hundred dollars; and also to contract for and cause to be oiled the cartridge boxes, belts and such other of the accoutrements now in the armory at the city of Annapolis as are made of leather; and they are hereby authorised to draw on the treasurer for the cost of the same.

Resolved, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be and he is hereby required to pay to the order of the Governor and Council, out of any unappropriated moneys in the treasury, the amount necessary to carry into effect the provisions of the foregoing resolution.

Passed Mar. 15. Resolution authorising the Register of the land office for the Western Shore to issue a patent to Alexander Shaffer.
