A bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 6 and 13, of an Act passed at the January session, 1872, chapter 244, entitled an Act to authorize the appointment of Weighers of Grain by the Governor, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 2, of the Act of 1870, chapter 77, entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Frostburg, in Allegany county, and to re-enact the same in an amended form.

The Joint Resolution instructing the Senators, and requesting the Representatives in Congress from Maryland, to use their best efforts to secure the passage of a law requiring the National Banks to retain in their vaults the gold interest they may receive from the United States Government, upon the reserve, &c.,
