Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 38 of Article XCIII. of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Testamentary Law,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Mr. Denson presented the petition of Martha Schaffer, for back pay due her under the Laws of 1867 and 1868.

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Pensions.

Mr. McCulloh, from the Committee on Pensions, reported favorably

A bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Comptroller to audit and pay Pensions to certain persons, soldiers of the war of 1812, and widows of soldiers of said war."

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Phelps, from a Select Committee reported favorably

A bill entitled "An Act to establish a State Board of Health."

Which read the first time and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Getty, from a Select Committee reported favorably

A bill entitled "An Act to add a sub-section to section 101, Article — of the Code of Public General Laws, title General Assembly sub-title Mileage."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Mr. Longwell, from a Select Committee reported favorably

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 181 of the Act of 1872, entitled an Act to repeal section 21 of Article VII. of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll county, sub-title Justice of the Peace and Constables, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to amend and re-enact the same."
