Section 12, strike out all after the word "Register," in line 20, and insert the following: "which lists shall be published as provided for in the 9th section of this Act."

Add to section 15, "and the residence herein referred to shall be construed so as to require that the party shall have spent a majority of the prescribed time in such ward or district."

Section 16, line 19, after word "district," insert "or who may not be residents, or entitled to vote in the ward or election district in which they are respectively registered."
