

Senate bill entitled an Act to protect rabbits and partridges and a class of small birds known as insectivorous birds, in Baltimore county,

Being on its third reading,

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 1, line 4, after the word "Baltimore county," insert "and Cecil county."

Section 3, line 8, substitute for the word "county," "counties."

In line 9, substitute for the word "county," "counties."

Section 4, line 2, substitute for the word "county," "counties."

Line 5, substitute for the word "county," "counties."

Amend title by inserting "and Cecil county," after the words "Baltimore county."
