CHAPTER 394.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section twenty-nine, of chapter thirty-six, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled, "an act to add a new article to the Code of Public General Laws, regulating the inspection of tobacco.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, By section twenty-nine, chapter thirty-six, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled, "an act to add a new article to the Code of Public General Laws, regulating the inspection of tobacco," it was enacted, that every hogshead of tobacco of this State that shall remain in any warehouse after being sold by the grower, for a longer period than twelve months, and any hogshead of tobacco, of the growth of any other state, whether sold or unsold, remaining in the warehouse a longer period than twelve months, the inspector of such warehouse shall charge the owner thereof, the sum of fifteen cents per hogshead storage, for each month after the said twelve months; and

Preamble

WHEREAS, Said enactment, being detrimental to the interest of the tobacco growers of this State, by not furnishing sufficient protection, especially to the tobacco of Maryland growth, therefore—

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That said section twenty-nine, of chapter thirty-six, of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled, "an act to add a new section to
