CHAP. 13.

*A Further and an additional Supplement to an act, entitled, An act concerning Crimes and Punishments.* Passed Jan. 21

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, the two directors of the Maryland penitentiary who may be designated by the governor and council as the Executive Committee, shall each enter into bond to the state of Maryland, with good and sufficient sureties, to be approved of by the governor and council, in the penal sum of five thousand dollars, conditioned for the true and faithful discharge of the duties which are now or may hereafter be required of them. Executive committee to give bond

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That if the executive committee, or either of them, shall fail to give the bond required by this act, within twenty days after the notification of his or their appointment, it shall be, and is hereby rendered the duty of the governor and council to appoint some other person or persons in his or their place. Proceedings in case of neglect

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the per diem compensation which is or may be allowed to each of the executive committee, by the board of directors, shall not exceed the sum of six hundred and twenty-five dollars in any one year. Compensation

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted* That nothing contained in the act of assembly passed at a December session one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight, chapter sixty-five, section the first, shall be construed to entitle the executive committee, or either of them, to any greater compensation than that which is provided for in the third section of this act. No greater allowance to be made

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with, or repugnant to the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal

CHAPTER 13.

*A Supplement to the act, entitled, An Act to erect a Town in Talbot County by the name of Saint-Michael's, and to appoint Commissioners.* Passed Jan. 21

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That so much of the act of eighteen hundred Act repealed
