No. 9.

Resolution in favor of the State Librarian.

Passed Jan. 24, 1833

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore, be and he hereby is authorised and directed to pay to the State Librarian annually, in addition to his present salary, the sum of three hundred dollars in quarterly payments.

No. 10.

Resolution requiring the treasurer of the western shore, to pay to his Excellency the Governor, or to his order, a certain sum of money therein mentioned.

Passed Jan. 24, 1833

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore, be and he is hereby directed to pay to his excellency the governor of Maryland, or his order, the sum of five hundred dollars, and the amount of the appropriation made at the last session of the legislature to the late governor, to be expended by him in procuring furniture and making repairs at the government house.
